Subject: Investigation Reports and Interim Orders are to be made public in the matter of the first disqualification & blacklisting of the applicant from NHEV with exceptional & extraordinary grounds of punitive actions exercised by piloting agency EoDB for the first time in NHEV pilot project.

Since April 2026, the pilot project has moved into the execution and on-ground infrastructure phase, involving land, real estate, construction, and related legal matters beyond its earlier focus on technology, policy, and commercial planning and financial instruments. This declassification of documents is aimed at ensuring transparency, accountability, timely project completion, and resolution of technical challenges, rather than enabling unwarranted litigation based on equivalences drawn from traditional procurement models. This is especially relevant as AHEM is a proprietary, and trademarked hybrid PPP model of NHEV currently in its fourth and final techno-commercial trial.

1. EoDB discourages non-serious applicants through phased disclosure of project impacts, risks, and stringent participation terms, allowing only those applicants who clearly understand that pilot participation is solely to validate the technical and commercial viability of their solutions, with established outcomes without any bias, lobby or arrangement that can warrant success or failure without trial. To address the recommendation to raise the bar, the proposed increase in the piloting fee, along with the additional scrutiny and documentation requirements, has been accepted.

2. At this stage, factual disclosures are necessary to prevent misinterpretation and protect genuine partners committed to advancing third-gen NHEV e-mobility infrastructure. While EoDB in general prefers facilitation, exemption, relaxations, extension, over disqualification of any partner or at max issue a caution to partner to be careful about actions that may lead to disqualification

3. As a 'piloting agency' EoDB is more focused to onboard genuinely interested and capable partners, rather than onboarding casual vendors and disqualifying them for petty non-compliance, late submissions. But strict timelines and compliance enforcement become essential to meet financial commitments, safeguard project assets, and ensure timely delivery of assets in this phase post April 2026.

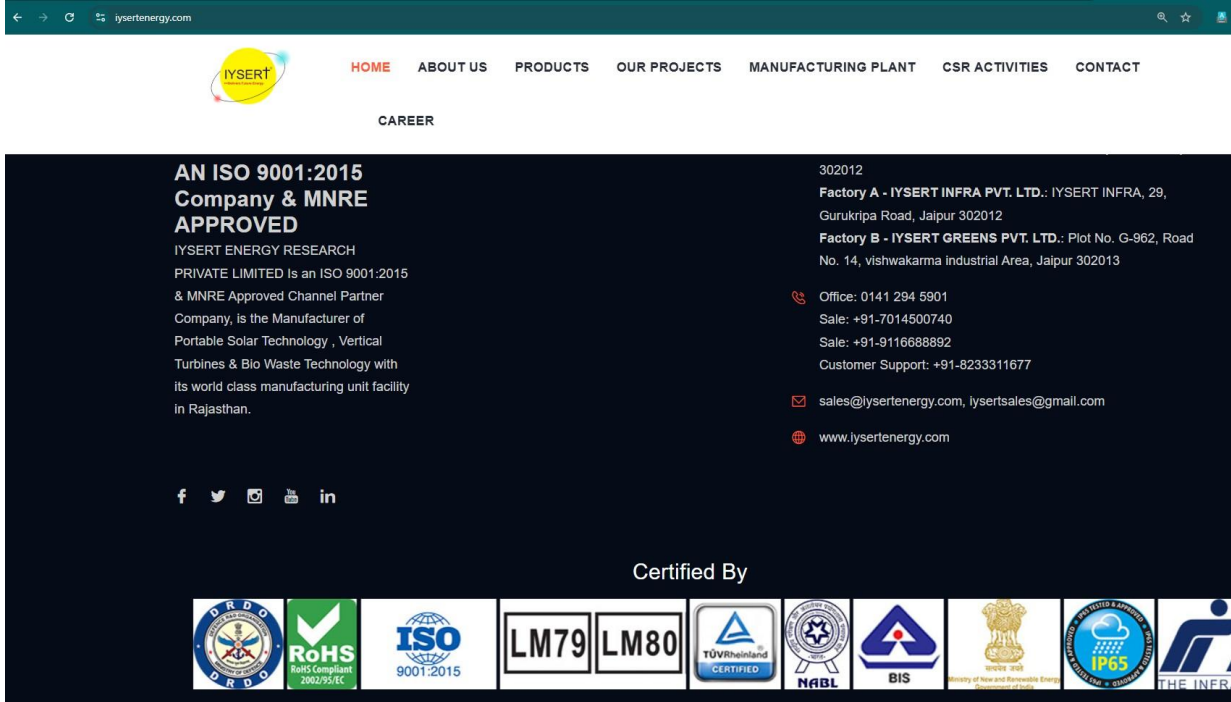

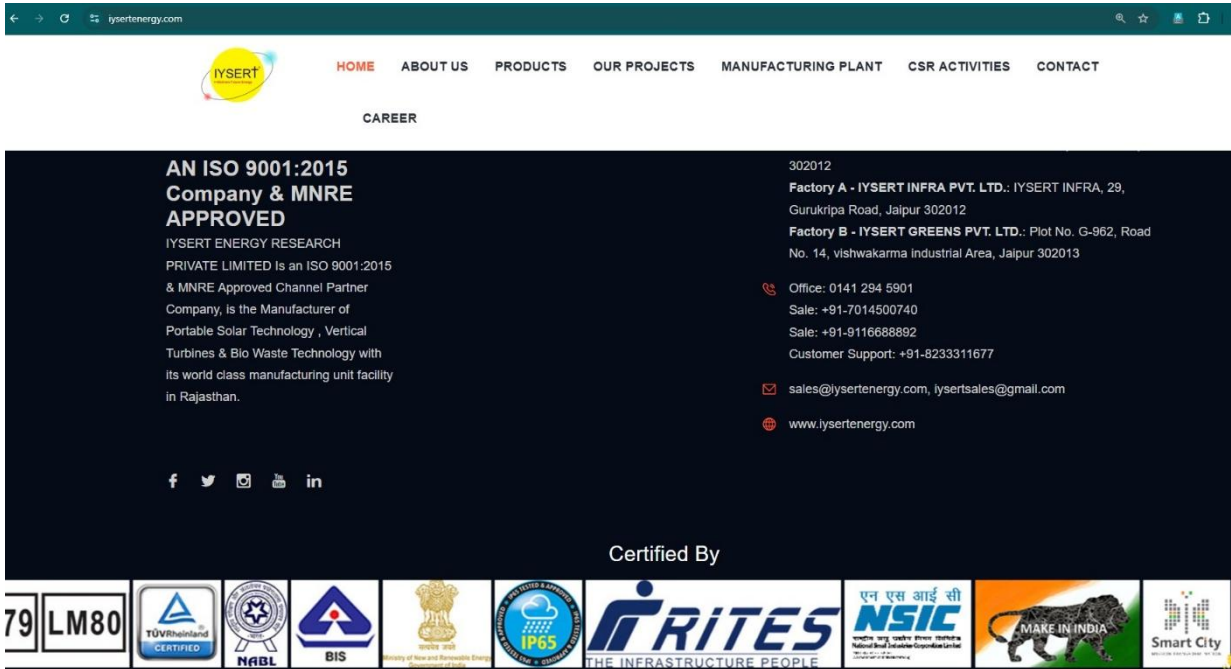

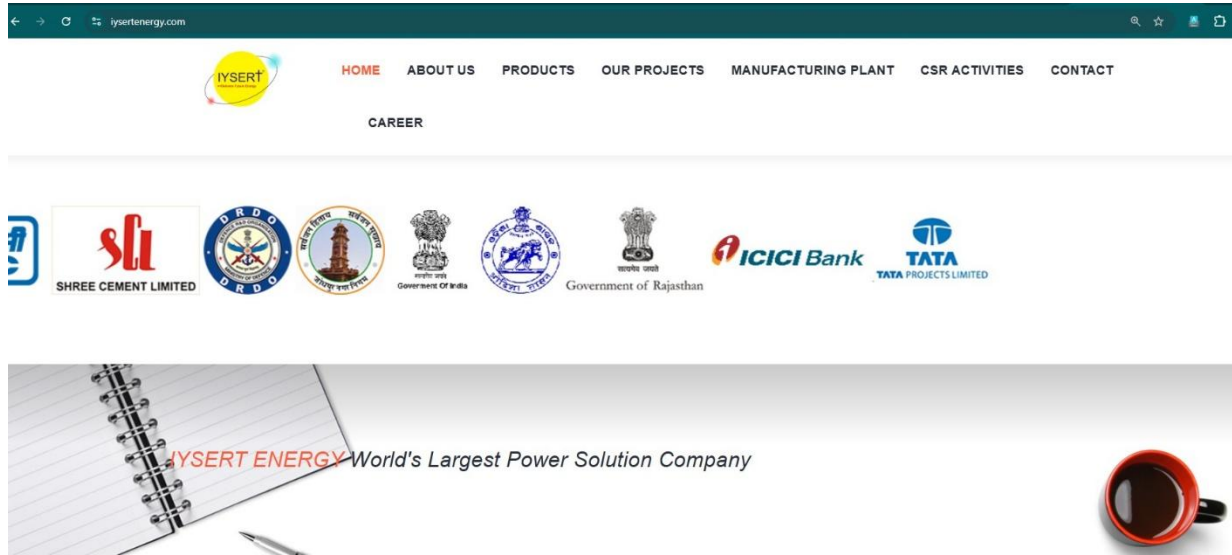
2N: Exhibit of unauthorised use of DRDO Logo as certification body



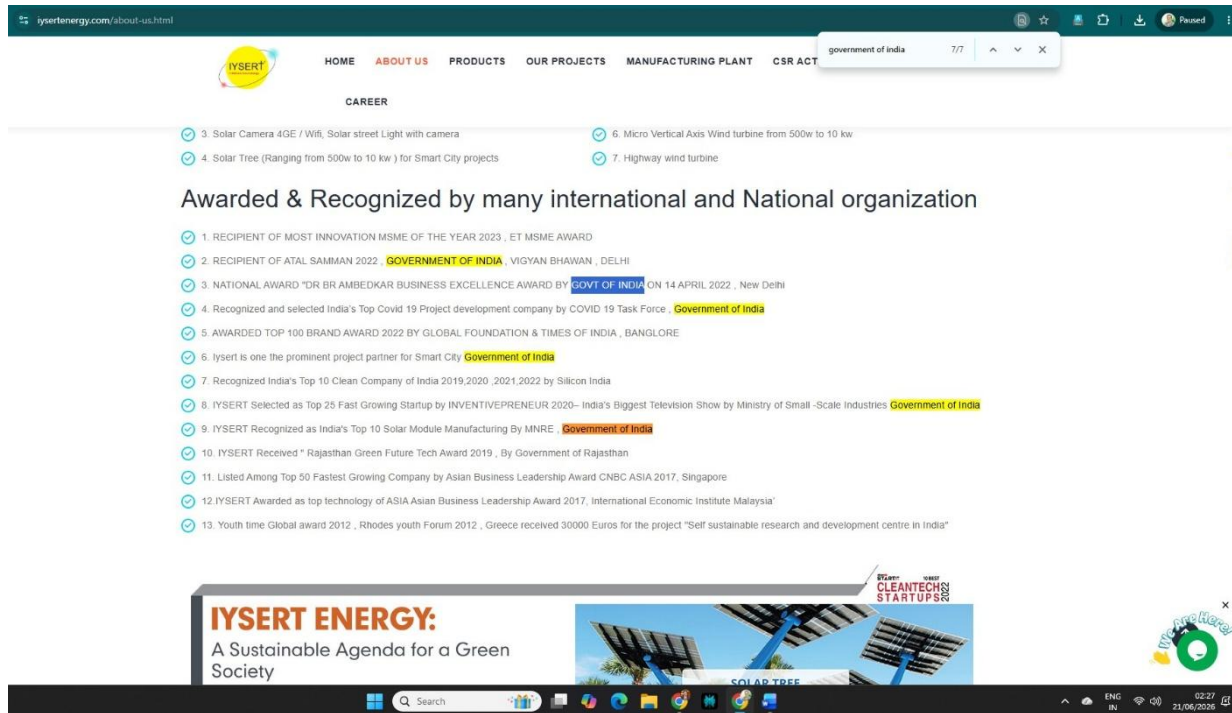
